## MULTIPLE RENDERING PROVIDERS IN ONE DAY

## UPDATE

## MARCH 23, 2018

As previously informed, the Maryland Department of Health and Beacon have resolved the billing issue with multiple ABA providers rendering direct services to a member on the same day. Providers can now begin submitting claims for two or more Medicaid enrolled staff who render direct ABA therapy to the same participant in a single day. These claims will now be paid for any services rendered since January 1, 2017.

Here is an example of how providers should submit these claims:

One staff works with a member for 1 hour before school. A different staff goes to the member's house for an additional 2-hour session that evening.

In this example, the claim should be submitted as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> staff: Bill one unit of 0364T for the first 30 minutes of service Bill 0365T for each remaining 30-minute period of service

2<sup>nd</sup> staff: Bill 0365T for each remaining 30-minute period of service
