Electronic Verification Requirements Reminder

March 6, 2020

Since Medicaid is ALWAYS the payer of last resort, MDH reminds providers that you must utilize existing resources to determine Medicaid and third party insurance coverage on your patients. Until Optum Maryland's Incedo Provider Portal is fully operational, providers must verify participant eligibility using Maryland's Medical Care Program's Electronic Verification System (EVS) to determine Medicaid eligibility and third party insurance coverage.

You can also utilize the interactive automated phone service (no sign-up required) by calling 1-866-710-1447 and follow the prompts.

This online function on Maryland's eMedicaid requires a one time, self-service registration. The registration flow creates an Administrator for that provider site. The Administrator creates accounts for users under a seven-digit provider "base number."

Providers are responsible for ensuring that they are meeting all required deadlines from third party insurers (typically 90 days) to submit for authorization prior to Medicaid.
