
Release of Information Question Added to Data Capture Form April 4, 2024

Target Audience: Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Providers

Effective April 6, 2024, an additional question will be added to the Data Capture form within Incedo to capture consumer Release of Information (ROI) data.

The question is titled **MCO SUD ROI Information** and states: "In order to improve coordination of care for all consumers, SUD providers are reminded to ensure that participants have had the opportunity to sign the Managed Care Organization Substance Use Disorder Release of Information (MCO SUD ROI) form that allows Optum to share with their MCO and primary care provider the fact that they are receiving SUD treatment."

Providers should select the appropriate response from the dropdown, shown below:



Selecting either "MCO SUD ROI signed with no limitations" **or** "MCO SUD ROI signed with limitations" will result in an additional required field: "Date that SUD MCO ROI was Signed."

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If the participant signed the SUD MCO ROI with limitations, the provider must immediately scan and email that document to directroifax@optum.com.



Please note:

- Providers must complete this information field for all data capture forms.
- Providers do not need to wait for authorization entry to complete this question.
