Further Information Regarding Multi-Factor Authentication in Incedo

Target Audience: All Behavioral Health Providers

In an April 10, 2024, <u>provider alert</u>, Optum communicated that multi-factor authentication (MFA) will be implemented for Incedo users on April 27, 2024.

Optum is currently testing this functionality with a number of providers to ensure a successful implementation. As we move closer to the implementation date, Optum has posted some educational materials to assist providers with the MFA process.

To further support this transition to MFA, Optum is:

- Currently hosting daily webinars in which MFA set-up is demonstrated. Please see times, dates and registration links on the <u>Provider Training Calendar</u>.
- Welcoming providers, and other organizations using Incedo, to join our testing phase, which includes MFA set-up prior to the planned launch date of April 27, 2024.
 - The process takes approximately 10 minutes and the Optum team is available to guide users through the process as needed.
 - Testing helps to ensure a smooth roll-out of MFA for all users, and allows testers to set-up their MFA with assistance from Optum staff.
