News and Reminders

- 1. Maryland saw over 2,800 drug overdose deaths, with 80% involving opioids like fentanyl, in 2021. **Please take a moment to watch this call-to-action video** from Maryland Department of Health Secretary Laura Herrera Scott to learn how healthcare providers and their teams are essential in addressing the overdose crisis. <u>Learn more</u> about free support from the Maryland Addiction Consultation Service.
- 2. **Critical Incident Reporting**: We are pleased to see that many providers are filing critical incident reports on the new forms described in this August 9, 2023 provider alert.
 - We are noticing that providers are filing a lot of reports concerning deaths that
 are not unexpected (e.g.: cancer, heart disease, etc.). Providers do **not** have to
 file reports in these instances; they are only needed when somebody dies
 unexpectedly, or there is a risk management issue (such as medication side
 effects, etc.).
- 3. Providers requesting authorizations for higher levels of care are reminded that these authorizations cannot overlap dates.
 - For example; if one authorization ends on September 1, the first day of the next authorization should be September 2.
 - Authorizations with overlapping dates will be voided.
- 4. On August 23, 2023, MDH released a transmittal titled "Clarification of Policy for Coverage of Behavioral Health Ancillary Services at Special Pediatric Hospitals." Please click here to view this transmittal.
- 5. Providers who have an outstanding estimated payment balance OR negative balance are reminded that these balances are due for repayment by December 31, 2023. Any balances that remain outstanding after that date will be referred to the Central Collections Unit (CCU).
 - Current balances are reported at the bottom of the weekly PRA and on the Claim Lifecycle Report.
