Incedo Fixes

A "hotfix" released to the Incedo system on December 12, resolved the following issues affecting Incedo Provider Portal (IPP) usage:

Authorization Requests:

- The county code should now be displayed properly.
- Provider authorization units that are displaying correctly are no longer being denied for "invalid units."
- Providers should now be able to successfully attach PDFs (up to 5 MB) to authorization requests.

Optum is still working to resolve some of the following issues in our January 2023 system update:

- There are still some difficulties regarding the tabbing functionality when directly adding a claim in Incedo.
- Some providers are seeing duplicated authorizations.
