Subject:	Updated Individual and Group Mental Health Practitioner Fee Schedule Effective January 1, 2025

The purpose of this transmittal is to provide notice of changes that Medicaid is making to the coding and reimbursement of psychotherapy codes for individual and group specialty mental health providers effective January 1, 2025.

The Department will begin reimbursing individual and group specialty mental health providers for:

- Code 90837 for 60 minutes of Individual psychotherapy and
- Evaluation & Management add-on Code 90838 for 60 minutes of Individual Psychotherapy.

The reimbursement rate is based on the provider's licensure type in the table below effective January 1, 2025.
