# Behavioral Health ASO Transition

The Maryland Medicaid Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization will transition to Carelon on tomorrow, January 1, 2025. Information regarding the transition is posted to <u>this webpage</u> and updates will also be posted here on the Provider Bulletin.

### Key Upcoming Dates:

- **12 p.m. (noon) EST, December 31, 2024:** Optum will accept Uninsured Requests and Participant Merge requests until noon on December 31, 2024. Merges that are open after this time will be transferred to Carelon.
- **December 31, 2024:** Providers will continue to submit authorization requests to Optum Maryland through 11:59 p.m., EST on December 31, 2024.
- Effective midnight (00:00) EST on January 1, 2025: Incedo will be accessible only in "read-only" mode until March 31, 2025, when access will be closed entirely.

- January 1, 2025: Carelon officially takes over as the Maryland PBHS ASO. All claims, authorizations, and clinical support materials should be submitted to Carelon via its <u>Provider Digital Front Door</u>.
- January 2, 2025: The final payment from Optum will occur on Thursday, January 2, 2025.
- January 6, 2025: Carleon's first check run takes place. Reminder: The first set of provider payments will be processed via paper check and mailed, whether included in this first check run or not. Payment processing and mail delivery times may vary.
- March 31, 2025: The Optum Maryland website <u>maryland.optum.com</u> will be taken down. All relevant information will be posted on <u>maryland.carelonbh.com</u>.

## Carelon Key Information:

 $\rightarrow$  Carelon's virtual office hours are scheduled every day at 11 a.m. from January 2 through January 17, 2025, for providers to ask one-off questions.
