Incedo Fixes

As part of ongoing work to correct issues that arose in the Incedo system following the 7.0 upgrade, Optum Maryland released a hotfix to the Incedo system on January 17. Fixes for the following issues were included in this release:

- Authorizations submitted with the correct number of units may be denied for invalid rate/frequency.
- Appeals and grievances; Letter attachments longer than 79 characters generate a "500 error" and the user is unable to proceed.
