News and Reminders

- 1. **Providers End-Dating IN PROCESS authorizations:** Providers are not able use the "END DATE" button to discharge authorizations that have the status of "In Process" (i.e., not yet approved/denied by Optum). In these instances, providers should use the Pencil Note function to add a note about the participant's discharge date. Clinical Care Advocates will update the discharge date when they review the in-process authorization. Instructions on how to use the Pencil Note field for this purpose are given here.
- Providers who have an outstanding estimated payment balance OR a negative balance are reminded that these balances are due for repayment by **December** 31, 2023. Any balances that remain outstanding after that date will be referred to the Central Collections Unit (CCU).

- Current balances are reported at the bottom of the weekly PRA and on the Claim Lifecycle Report.
