- 1. March is Problem Gambling Awareness Month.

- 2. To facilitate precertification at the time of admission and save providers' time, Optum Maryland wishes to remind facilities to utilize the unfunded span to obtain authorizations for participant's they believe will obtain Medicaid coverage.
 - When the authorization is obtained using the unfunded span, as soon as the
 participant's Medicaid coverage is active, the provider can bill if authorization was
 approved based on medical necessity criteria.
 - The patient's <u>Incedo record</u> will automatically update when Medicaid coverage becomes active.
- 3. The next Provider Council Meeting will be held on March 8 at 10:00 am. Please <u>click</u> <u>here</u> to register.
- 4. An issue impacting access to the Optum Maryland website occurred on the morning of Friday, March 1. The issue was resolved by 10:30 a.m., EST on March 1st.
 - The Optum team confirmed the root cause involved expiration of a digital certificate associated with the website.
 - After analyzing the issue, Optum identified that certificate renewal was the correct remediation and after completion, Optum validated return to usual website operations.
 - This issue was specific to the Optum-owned and -operated website (<u>Maryland.optum.com</u>), and did not impact Incedo or any other web-based applications used in Maryland.
