Effective Tuesday, February 22, the State of Maryland confirmed the Governor's February 14, 2022 announcement that state employees and visitors would no longer be required to wear masks while in state-owned and leased buildings. Please note that MDH Healthcare Facilities and other MDH locations may be subject to other requirements.
