New ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes Added to Mental Health and Poisoning Diagnosis Lists

September 26, 2024

Target Audience: All Behavioral Health Providers

The Maryland Department of Health (MDH) has approved 32 new ICD-10 diagnosis codes to the diagnosis lists and removed 3 previously used codes.

The <u>Mental Health Diagnosis list</u> has been updated to remove the following codes, effective September 30, 2024:

F5001	Anorexia nervosa, restricting type
F5002	Anorexia nervosa, binge eating/purging type
F502	Bulimia nervosa

The following codes have been added, effective October 1, 2024:

T45AX2A	Poisoning by immune checkpoint inhibitors and immunostimulant drugs,
	intentional self-harm, initial encounter
T50992A	Poisoning by other drugs, medicaments and biological substances, intentional
	self-harm
T6102XA	Ciguatera fish poisoning, intentional self-harm, initial encounter
T6112XA	Scombroid fish poisoning, intentional self-harm, initial encounter
T61772A	Other fish poisoning, intentional self-harm, initial encounter
T61782A	Other shellfish poisoning, intentional self-harm, initial encounter
