- If enrolled with Payspan under Beacon, you will still need to complete the enrollment process with Payspan for Optum

Authorization Request and Approval Process

- Authorization plans have been set up with a list of the service codes and corresponding number of units
- If multiple service codes are selected the correct units should be visible in the units field
- If a change in the number of units is requested, the user will be able to update the number of units up to the max number of units that is defined for that service code
- Be sure to select Brain injury as the Participant's 'insurance'



Authorization Request and Approval Process

- Search for BI Waiver Eligible Participant
- Complete the Brain Injury waiver form & Data capture form
- Complete the Authorization Request
- TBI Waiver services are authorized, and must be approved by BHA
- Providers can view the status of their authorization via Incedo Provider Portal
